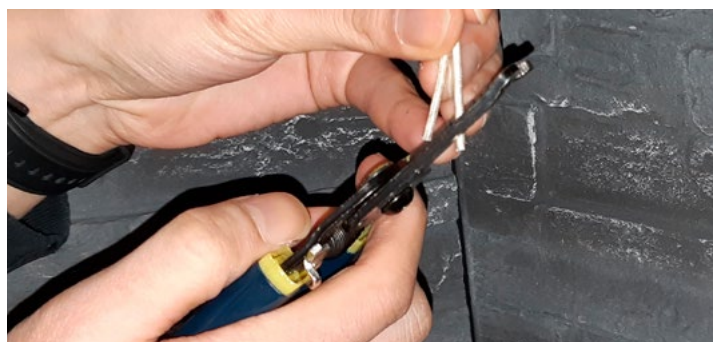
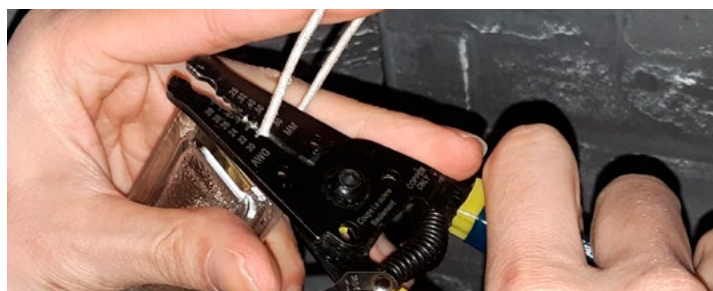


Assembly

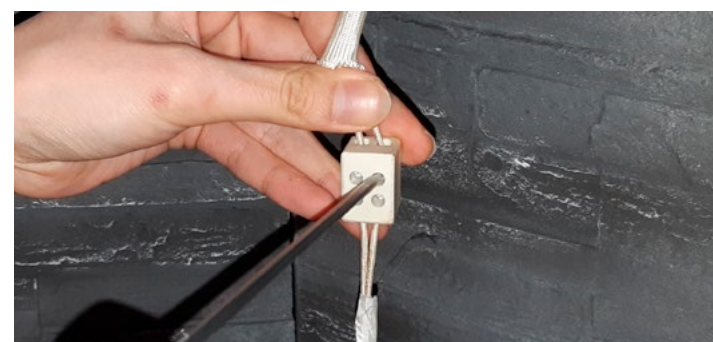
1 Using a Phillips bit, remove the two screws securing the light to the firebox ceiling. Carefully pull the housing from the ceiling.



2 Cut the 2 wires from the dead or damaged light, then using a stripper, remove 1/4" of insulation from the wires and twist.



3 The wires are then inserted into the terminal block and secured with a Flathead screwdriver. Wrap the terminal block, wires, and insulation with fiberglass tape to prevent the wires from coming in contact with the firebox



4 Insert the light back into the firebox ceiling as shown below, note the securing tab on the wired side of the light.
